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COURSE DESCRIPTION

Beginning Korean I is the first part of the Beginning Korean series. In this course you will develop low-beginning level proficiency in Korean in the five areas of language competencies: speaking, listening, reading, writing, and cultural knowledge. The objective of this course is to help you learn vocabulary and the alphabet, short expressions, simple grammar, and various aspects of the Korean culture, that are necessary for basic communications in Korean.

You will have a variety of authentic language and cultural experiences through interactions with native speakers of Korean, as their assistance is arranged for course projects and requirements. The course will help you build a solid foundation for the next level of the Korean course: Beginning Korean II (KOREAN1020).

c. Homework assignments	You will complete a Writing/Grammar Worksheet assignment for each chapter. This assignment can be completed during your visit to a Korean tutor.	(20%)
d. Culture /Language portfolio	Portfolio entries will consist of: a) a video tape of your oral performance (Group project), b) Two 1- page reports on a cultural activity with a Korean friend (group project), c) 4 printouts of email messages with Korean friends, e) 20 pages of personalized picture dictionary, f) 3-5 of your Culture Worksheets completed in class (e.g. a Korean movie day worksheet, etc.), and g) an audio file of your oral performance. You will give a presentation on selected entries at the end of the semester (5 % of the portfolio points).	(20%)
e. Tutor sessions	You are required to attend one tutor session (20 min. - 1 hr.) each week for conversational Korean.	(10%)
f. Attendance & participation	Course attendance and participation are crucial for this course as you will develop your oral skills through various class activities. If you miss a class, you need to contact your classmates or your instructor for information before the next class meeting.	(10+%)
