Program Dates:	Fall Semester: September - December; Spring Semester: January - May
Program Costs:	~\$6,900 per semester
Included:	USU resident tuition and fees, housing, meals and medical insurance for program dates
Not Included:	Airfare, passport, visa, local transportation, and other personal/miscellaneous expenses
Credit:	To earn credits toward USU graduation requirements, you must plan in advance with your academic advisor.
Accommodations:	Included in the program fee: Choice of residence hall with kitchen facilities or home stay program (available on a semester basis). Home stay may be extended to a whole year depending on the family's approval and the student's academic performance.
Insurance:	USU provides a comprehensive medical insurance policy for program dates only. For more information go to: www.usu.edu/riskmgmt/other/international/cfm . Participants may purchase up to 7 days of personal travel insurance after the program. Contact USU Risk Management for details.
Requirements:	GPA: 3.0; Minimum age: 18; Completion of one-year of university-level study before program begins.

Academic Notes:	Students will participate in the Asian Studies Program. Students are encouraged to take four courses, including a required course in Japanese, in beginning through advanced levels. Student Orientation:	Participants must complete on-line orientation modules through Canvas and attend one in-person pre-departure session.
