- To be accepted and declared an On-Line Spanish Minor you must have 3.00 Overall GPA minimum on your USU transcript.

- To graduate with On-Line Spanish Minor you must have 3.00 GPA combined with all Spanish upper division classes.

- Currently, lower division Spanish classes SPAN 1010, 1020, 2010 and 2020 are offered through USU broadcast courses. SPAN 1010 and 2010 in the Fall semesters, SPAN 1020 and 2020 in the Spring semesters. Testing for placement in any class above SPAN 1010 must be done through Darla Moore at the Logan Campus LPCS Department. See her information above.
