Note: Important Information to be a Spanish Minor

*A student wishing to become a Spanish Minor will be accepted only through an application process conducted twice a year. **Deadlines are Feb. 15th & Oct. 15th.***

Minimum Requirements for application:

- *Complete at least one of the following courses at USU: **SPAN 3060 or SPAN 3300.***
- *Have a minimum USU GPA of 3.00 and **OVERALL GPA of 3.00***
- *Have a minimum GPA of 3.00 for all Spanish (SPAN) courses taken at USU.*

To access the Canvas Spanish Minor Application Process, contact Darla Moore in Main 204, darla.moore@usu.edu or call 435-797-1209. Application to the Spanish Minor is a competitive process. Meeting the minimum requirements does not guarantee admittance.

NOTE: To graduate with a Spanish minor you must have a 3.00 GPA within the Spanish minor classes.

Spanish Minor (15 credits) (3.00 GPA required in all Spanish Minor classes)

Please note all minor courses require a minimum grade of C- or better and may not be taken on a pass/fail basis except for SPAN 3010, 3520 and 4920. In addition, at least half (50%) of credits must be completed through USU or its sponsored programs. An On-Line Spanish Minor has different requirements (see On-Line Spanish Minor website information). This also means all of the Spanish Minor classes have to be done on-line in order to complete the on-line minor.
