

Spanish Language & Culture – Summer Study Abroad Faculty-Led Program

- Program Outline:** This is a 4-week, USU faculty-led program at the University of La Rioja Fundación in Logroño, Spain. Beginning - advanced language, literature, and culture courses are offered. Classes are taught by qualified, native Spanish speakers/instructors from the Fundación. A USU faculty member will be onsite for full program dates. All academic standards and procedures will be observed as if on campus in Logan.
- Program Dates:** June 26, 2017 – July 21, 2017
- Program Costs:** Tuition (2016-2017 Resident Tuition available here: <http://www.usu.edu/registrar/tuition/> plus 5% estimated increase) plus Program fee (\$2,000-\$2,400 estimated)
- Included:** Tuition and fees (TBD based on new tuition tables for 16-17)
- Not Included:** Airfare, most local transportation, books, some meals, passport, visa (if necessary), and personal/ miscellaneous expenses.
- Credit:** Register for 6 credits from the following: SPAN 1800, 2800, 3650, 3800, or 4800. Plan carefully with your USU academic advisor for articulation of classes toward your academic degree program.
- Accommodations:** Fundación will arrange family homestay (1 USU student per family) with 3 meals/day, or residence hall (no meals or laundry service included, reduction in program fee TBD).
- Requirements:** GPA: 2.75 Minimum age: 18; Valid passport; Visa (needed for non-U.S. citizens). Acceptance is subject to program leader approval.
- Academic Notes:** Students take a language placement test upon arrival in Spain for proper class selection.
- Application Fee:** \$150 (due with application), non-refundable unless determined ineligible.
- Payment Schedule:** A \$500 deposit will be due March 15th, final payment will be due April 15th.
- Student Orientation:** A Study Abroad Health and Safety Orientation and corresponding Canvas course (a pre-requisite for the study abroad program) will be held in Spring 2017 prior to program. Other program specific meetings will be arranged by the program leader.
