Eligibility Requirements

- Applicants must be a student in good standing at USU.
- Academic major in Spanish.
- Record must show at least one-half (17) credits completed in the Spanish major program.
- Students must have earned 91 credit hours (have Senior status) at the beginning of the award year.
- Recipients must take at least one upper division class in Spanish and show satisfactory progress toward the degree during the award year.

Award Criteria

The recipient of this scholarship will be selected by:

- Grade point average in the major (Major GPA will be given double weight)
- Overall grade point average

If, in the view of the scholarship committee, there is no truly outstanding applicant, the scholarship will be withheld.
