Eligibility Requirements:

- Applicants must be an academic major in Languages.
- Applicants' record must show a minimum of 9 upper division credits toward the major that they have either taken at USU or are currently enrolled in at USU.
- Applicants must have at least one more semester of classes to complete at USU.
- Applicants must have a 3.0 or higher GPA in the major

Award Criteria:

- GPA in major
- Overall GPA
- Breadth of education
- Intellectual potential
- Preference is given to Female students with 3.0 or above GPA
- Finalists may be invited to an interview with the scholarship committee

Essay Requirements:

Applicants must attach a typed essay no longer than two double-spaced pages to the application. The essay should address the following questions:

1. Who are you and why do you deserve consideration for this award?
2. What is the value of studying languages?
3. What do you intend to do with your language degree?
