

Philosophy Minor Requirements

Required Courses (18 credits) (2.5 GPA required)

A minor in philosophy may be obtained by completing **six** philosophy courses, at least four of which must be at the upper-division level. At least half (50 percent) of the credits earned for this minor must be completed in USU courses offered by the LPCS department. Minimum Grade for each class is C- or better. Up to 3 *pass/fail* credits in philosophy courses may be applied toward the philosophy minor. To graduate with this minor, a 2.5 GPA is required within minor coursework.
